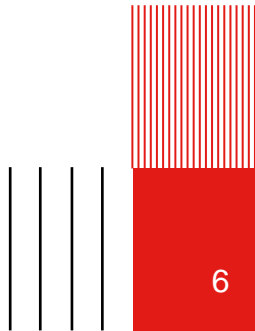
Grading System (New) – A to F

PUNCTUALITY

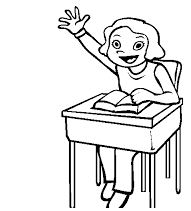
- Arrive on time for class at 12:30 PM.
