PRESENTATION SKILLS /5

Voice

- Has fluid rhythm and debit
- Is dynamic and confident
- Has no or limited hesitations (euh, euh...)
- Articulates clearly and can be heard by everyone

Body Language

- Uses calm natural gestures
- Avoids nervous movement (hands, feet, barriers, etc.)

Eye contact

- Looks at all audience members
- Has no or limited use of notes/no reading
- Avoids looking at poster all the time

CONTENT + STRUCTURE /5

Introduction

- Introduces themselves
- Presents context, objectives and any specifications
- Grabs audience's attention

Conclusion

- A clear conclusion and take-home message
- Thank the audience and ask for questions

Transitions

- Uses clear and appropriate transitions between parts of presentation
- Uses signposting language

Clear Story and relevant content

- Informative content; not too detailed or vague.
- A clear 'story' to the presentation; sections presented in a logical order with a clear connection between sections (results and conclusion replies to aim)
